The Clemson Rugby Foundation has been able to reach a major milestone thanks to all of its generous members and supporters. We are proud to announce that the foundation met the fund raising goal of 2009 by raising \$15,000. A big thank you from the foundation board members on making this possible!

We had several successful events that made reaching this goal possible. The foundation is already planning the 2010 events.

Recent Progress - Trainer and New Award

The foundation is pleased to announce that a professional trainer paid for by the CRF has started to work with the team. John Doe is a qualified trainer working with company x. John Doe is attending two practices a week and each home game. There has been a very positive response from the team and Coach Wright regarding the presence of a trainer.
