CRF Fundraising Results - 2012

Matching gifts can get us to \$30,000

We closed out the year just under the \$29,000 mark in contributions collected and known matching gifts in process. There is a great opportunity to see additional contributions from matching gift programs from your employer. This is an easy way to double your contribution and impact your gift has on the teams. Check with your Human Resource department or manager if your company has a matching gifts program. We are familiar with the paperwork associated with completing a matching gift request. While we missed our goal of \$35,000 in 2012, the shortfall is not due to a lack of interest or support. Contributors from every generation of Clemson Rugby are represented in our membership and supporter list. What is truly incredible is that we reached this figure with only 64 contributors. These generous contributors include members of Clemson Rugby's first team in 1967, to women's team alumnae, student families and professors. We have reached out to all associations of the Clemson Rugby experience to gain their support. The stories we hear are incredible and the on-going passion for Clemson Rugby is inspiring. We have continued to add new supporters to our membership and we will tackle the challenge of reaching all of our alumni, past supporters and family in 2013.

We surpassed \$100,000 in 2012

New fields approved by Trustees Outdoor Wellness and Fitness Center moves forward

Last week, the Clemson University Board of Trustees approved the conceptual plans for a \$7 million project that includes two new athletic fields. These fields have been developed with rugby competition in mind and University leaders have been engaged with the student ruggers for several months seeking their input. The plans for the space call for two natural grass surfaces with irrigation, competition lighting, as well as proper grading and drainage. The fields are part of a larger plan to redevelop the old Y-Beach and Recreation Area. There is an incredible opportunity to create a home for Clemson Rugby at this facility and the University is seeking our support.
