By following this code of conduct, I will make my contribution to keeping Clemson Rugby Foundation a highly respected organization for rugby players now and in the future. The Clemson Rugby Foundation expects all <u>players and participants</u> to abide by the following code of conduct:

- 1. I am an Ambassador of Clemson Rugby. As such, I understand that I am expected to demonstrate good and responsible behavior both on and off the pitch.
- 2. I will Respect the Rules of Rugby. I will play by the rules of the game.
- 3. I will show Good Sportsmanship towards my Teammates, Coaches, Opponents, Spectators and Officials at all times.
- 4. I will Respect all Teammates, Officials, Coaches, and Parents. I will play the game with sportsmanship and good character. I will treat my opponents respectfully on and off the field. I will treat my opponents' parents, supporters, coaches, and staff with respect. I will treat my opponents' facilities with respect.
- 5. I will NOT engage in obscene, profane, racist, sexist, or bigoted jokes, statements, displays, or activities.
- 6. I will NOT exhibit antisocial, damaging, or dangerous behavior of any sort that would adversely affect the image of the game as a serious and disciplined endeavor. This includes physical and mental abuse of players, coaches, officials and spectators.
- 7. I understand that I will not be able to participate in any contact rugby without a protective mouthpiece.
- 8. I will NOT procure, use, or provide controlled substances (alcohol, other drugs, cigarettes for minors, etc.) or tolerate procurement, use, or provision of such substances by my fellow players, participants, staff, or supporters. This matter is of such concern that this is a Zero-Tolerance policy.
- 9. I will be a Team Player. I will be open to Learning. I will do my utmost to have fun. I will adopt the 'Sweep the Sheds' mentality; which is to leave something better than you found it, clean up after myself, pick up the gear at the end of a session, and Respect the Values of Rugby at all times.

This Code of Conduct is meant as a guide for youth athletes participating in a Clemson Rugby Foundation Rugby Camp. The CRF wants every participant to have fun and enjoy their rugby experience. The CRF wants to promote a healthy, fun, and safe environment where young people can learn athletic skills, sportsmanship, the value of teamwork, and good character.
